SILVER BREEZE rated nicely behind the pace, dropped to the rail for the stretch drive and got through then drew off. STRIKES OF THUNDER set a pressured pace and battled into the stretch and held well for place. BOX CAR BABY broke outward and bumped MY GALLOP, raced close up the entire way, led late and held on gamely. LEMON MERINGUE exchanged bumps at the start with MISSY WILDCAT, saved ground the entire way and hit her best stride too late. MISSY WILDCAT exchanged bumps with LEMON MERINGUE at the start and took back, had an inside trip down the backstretch and through the turn, angled out for the stretch drive and was closing too late. MY GALLOP was squeezed at the start and dropped back, made a four wide bid then flattened out. HONEY'S HUMOR broke inward and bumped MY GALLOP, was asked while four wide in the turn but made no rally. ELEGANT WARRIOR pressed the pace then came off the rail in the turn and tired in the stretch. UNDER SAIL raced in the second flight between horses and was through after a half.
