MEC DANCER was settled into stride off the second flight racing a bit off the inside to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention outside foes on the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch and produced a steady late response to prevail in time under firm handling. FAN TAN MAN, pulling a bit against restraint racing three wide in the second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress in that path to draw on terms with the leaders nearing upper stretch, was roused clear between calls leaving the furlong marker but proved no match when confronted by the winner. DRIFTING WIND angled to the inside while being urged to the lead, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the far turn, briefly resisted racing to midstretch and continued with interest to edge a rival for a share. CHIEF WANDO gained terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, stalked that foe under reserve racing to the far turn, moved to press the issue between foes into upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort through the last furlong. LIMESTONE was settled off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. ROAD MAN was settled outside foes racing to the far turn and never gained contention. MAGIC MAN broke awkwardly, was quickly righted while gaining a position inside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued in that position into the second bend and steadily faded racing into the stretch. GIRLS CHOICE tracked the leaders unhurried between foes in the second flight in the opening half but came up empty racing through the far turn.
