### Footnotes

COLOR ME BLUE was settled in last while in hand racing just off the inside in the opening half, commenced a steady advance while shifting out three deep entering the turn, wrested command nearing midstretch and drew clear late under firm right handed prompting. HE'S BONAFIDE, unhurried tracking the leaders off the inside from just out of striking distance in the opening half, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late effort to prove best of the others. SILVER CRAFT was urged to dispute the pace near the inside in the opening stages, edged forward to a narrow advantage leaving the turn, shifted off the inside while briefly resisting the winner's challenge but proved no match for the top pair in late stages. HYDRO POWER joined the pace outside foes soon after the start, pressed a rival for command racing into the turn and gave way after six furlongs. BEAUCHAMP VICEROY (GB) was urged to secure a forward placing along the rail in the opening quarter, tracked just off the top pair racing into the bend but steadily retreated entering upper stretch.
