Footnotes

PRIME SPEED, pulling a bit while gaining a forward placing in the opening furlong, was taken back off the pace entering the first turn, continued to be reserved from just out of striking distance through the backstretch, commenced a steady bid splitting foes three deep entering the far turn to challenge for command in tandem with HENDERSON racing into upper stretch, then turned back that foe racing through the stretch to narrowly prevail under brisk handling. The latter, reserved saving ground in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing the far turn, moved to challenge in tandem with the winner racing four wide through the far turn, pressed the issue outside the winner past midstretch and was just outfinished. PROUD NATION, reserved between foes from off the second flight in the opening stages, angled to the inside nearing the backstretch, steadily drew into contention entering the far turn, was shuffled a bit in traffic after six furlongs, shifted out to split foes three deep in upper stretch and made steady progress to the end to close the gap and gain a share. JACK'S TIGER, held up when pinched back out of tight quarters not longer after the start, continued unhurried between foes to the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position three deep between foes in late stages. COCKY BULL, reserved saving ground off the second flight in the opening half, shifted outside foes on the far turn, raced four wide into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. PLAYON PLAYER, close up between foes racing to the first turn, was eased off the pace nearing the backstretch to track just off the leaders, made a brief second effort entering the far turn but quickly came up empty. MILKY MAY, urged to the lead along the inside from the break, set the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn and gave way once headed nearing upper stretch. STAR RATING broke awkwardly, was urged to contention along the inside, split foes entering the backstretch to force the pace but was spent after five furlongs. LO ME settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge.
