Footnotes

SPRINGTIME SPELL gained terms with a rival on the pace from the outset, pressed the issue on the turn to gain the advantage nearing upper stretch, shook clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady handling. NETWORKING, caught in some tight quarters at the start, tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside as part of the second flight, shifted a bit off the rail to split foes advancing in close quarters nearing the furlong marker and proved best of the others. ROSE MOUNTAIN tracked the pace three deep between foes as part of the second flight racing into the turn, was fanned four wide in upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the top pair but edged a rival for third on the wire. STONE FREE tracked the leaders between foes just off the inside in second flight racing into the turn, shifted out three deep between foes racing through the stretch and was outfinished for a share. LEAHA'S PRINCESS, caught four deep in second flight early, angled to the inside on the turn dropping back from that position and lacked a closing response. BARB'S BUCKLES broke readily, disputed the lead inside a rival racing into the bend and gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
