SUNTRACER, a bit slow into stride, settled in hand along the inside for a half, shifted outside a rival entering the far turn, commenced his advance midway through the second bend, angled five wide in upper stretch, produced a solid late response while shifting inwards under pressure and just edged MR. MISCHIEF on the wire under energetic handling. The latter broke readily to secure a clear advantage along the inside, dictated the pace in hand to the backstretch, turned back several challengers racing into the far turn to regain a clear advantage, held sway past the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner. PRINCEVILLE CONDO shifted out early while taking up a position in the second flight, advanced three deep on the backstretch to gain striking distance, continued in that path to upper stretch while being urged to challenge, couldn't match the top pair but edged a rival for a share. MAVERICKING, reserved just off the second flight while guided to the inside early, advanced along the rail to bid inside foes leaving the far turn but lacked the needed final response. SNAPPED tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. TAZZ delayed proceedings in the paddock when requiring a shoe repair, was pulling his rider along in the opening stages while leading the second flight on a narrow margin into the backstretch, prompted the leader between foes midway through the backstretch, continued to dispute the issue between foes on the second bend and gave way leaving midstretch. TAPTOWNE settled near the inside early and never seriously menaced.
