PEYOTE PATTY pulled her way to terms with a rival on the pace, attended the leader's tempo under firm reserve for a half, lost some position to the pacesetter on the second bend but continued with a steady response under firm encouragement to regain terms with that foe and narrowly prevail in time under strong handling. KATIE THE LADY broke outwards brushing ONE LAST DANCE, was prompted to secure the advantage along the inside, dictated terms to her foes on a narrow margin while under light rating in the opening half, edged away to a clear advantage on the second bend, held sway to late stages but couldn't quite fend off the winner's final bid. CUMULONIMBLE was rated outside a rival in the second flight racing just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted out three deep racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while narrowly prevailing for a share. HOOH WHY was guided to the inside while under reserve to track the leaders as part of the second flight in the opening stages, lost some position to the leaders racing into the second bend but continued with interest nearest the rail in late stages to make some belated progress while closing the gap. ONE LAST DANCE, brushed at the start, was settled into stride near the inside in last racing to the backstretch and passed only tiring rivals. PATHWAY tracked off the second flight under light rating in the opening half but couldn't produce the needed closing response. ALL FOR THEE settled into stride off the second flight near the inside and never seriously menaced.
