**Footnotes**

RAIN RAY tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight from just out of striking distance in the opening half, commenced a steady, three wide to challenge racing into upper stretch and went clear under firm right handed pressure. WALK THE WALK switched out early while being prompted to secure a forward placing, continued with a steady bid to press the issue into the far turn, shifted out resisting the winner's bid racing through the stretch but proved only second best. SIR KIPLING settled into stride along the inside, shifted out splitting foes racing through the far turn and continued with an effort to improve position. TACTICS BEST, urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. LEOPOLIS tracked the pace inside a rival in the second flight but came up empty racing through the far turn. JACOB'S LIGHTHOUSE tracked off the second flight three deep early but soon dropped out.
