Footnotes

ULTIMO TRAGO angled inwards in the opening stages while moving to terms with the pacesetter, attended that rival's pace under rating into the backstretch, continued with a steady bid prompting that foe racing through the far turn to upper stretch and took over late under pressure. HE'S DANN GOOD tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight early, switched out nearing the far turn, continued with a four wide run into upper stretch and secured the place honors late. LAYTHATPISTOLDOWN moved to the fore along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the far turn, briefly resisted the winner into upper stretch but gave out late. FIRE CLOUD tracked off the first flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance three deep on the turn but had no final kick. DOCTOR TROTTER settled into stride along the inside early but never gained striking distance. CAPTAIN MARVIN never mounted a serious challenge. SHOOT THE LOOP settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. BIG BAD MIKE was a brief factor between foes in second flight racing into the backstretch but faded early.
