FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND OLDER. Nominations close Wednesday, August 2, 2006 with no fee. \$150 to enter and \$150 additional to start with \$45,000 added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights; Three year olds 121 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2006 allowed 2 lbs. Of \$35,000 once or \$22,000 twice at a mile or over in 2006, 4 lbs. Of \$28,000 once or \$18,000 twice since November 1, 2005, 6lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered.) The field will be limited to 12 starters. Highweights on the scale preferred. Total earnings in 2005 / 2006 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (onn the scale). Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Nominations Closed Wednesday, August 2, 2006 with 24.

SAMPSON'S SON raced close up off the rail, rallied to the lead in the stretch and drew off while ridden out. STRAIGHT LINE raced close up four wide, rallied in the stretch and gained the place while not a threat. TAP DANCING MAUK lacked speed while racing six wide and rallied belatedly for a share. CAMPTOWN KING lacked speed inside, steadied in the stretch and rallied mildly. SILVER VISTA raced near the middle of the field, came out from a left handed whip in the stretch and lacked a bid. HIGH EXPECTATIONS saved ground but gave way. CONNECTIONS set the pace from the inside and tired. BUDDY GIL lost ground steadily.
