BACKSTABBER tracked just off and outside the first flight in the opening stages, swung out four wide entering upper stretch while commencing a steady advance, took over leaving the sixteenth marker and pulled clear under pressure. MAWAAQEF angled to the rail while gaining terms with a rival on the lead, attended that foe's pace under some reserve racing into the turn, dueled for command into upper stretch, couldn't fend off the winner but held the place. THIEF IN D'HOOD tracked the leaders along the inside as part of the second flight, shifted out in late stages and made an effort to improve position. EXCHANGE IN MOTION prompted the pace outside a rival from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened late. Mescalero Agave broke inwards into the path of FIJI STAR (ARG), was collected to track the leaders off the inside, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild response. FIJI STAR (ARG), carried inwards at the start, was settled off the inside racing to the turn but offered no rally. PAPA JIGGS tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight racing into the bend but steadily retreated entering upper stretch. SO CO bobbled at the start and trailed throughout.
