Footnotes

DADE BABE pulled her way clear racing into the first turn, set the tempo on a comfortable margin to the second bend, went clear again when challenged to open a commanding margin nearing midstretch and held safe the challenge of WILD MIA under firm encouragement. The latter came under firm rating after the opening furlong to track the pacesetter from just out of striking distance while angling inside, shifted off the rail exchanging some contact with FAR FROM SHY midway through the backstretch while commencing her advance, switched out four deep in upper stretch, closed the gap with a sharp move in the last furlong but proved only second best. SWEETBRIAR ACADEMY, reserved saving ground in the opening stages, continued along the inside through the second bend, shifted out to split foes racing through the stretch and continued willingly for a share. FAR FROM SHY, held up along the inside in the opening stages, angled out after a half while exchanging some contact with a rival, made an effort to improve her placing in the final stages but had no closing bid. BORN INDY U S A angled inwards to gain position just off the second flight, advanced on the pacesetter to briefly challenge that foe on the far turn but flattened out entering upper stretch. THE MIZZUS was urged to secure a position outside a rival in second flight in the opening stages, made a brief bid between foes on the far turn but soon retreated nearing upper stretch. NEED MORE LUCK was settled outside foes in the opening half and never seriously menaced.
