Footnotes

HOOH WHY gained a position tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance while in hand racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance three deep entering the second bend to challenge for command in upper stretch, ducked outwards a bit approaching the furlong marker, then shifted inwards under firm right handed pressure to edge clear in the last furlong. ASKBUT I WON'TTELL, unhurried in early stages while shifting a bit off the inside racing well off the second flight, made steady progress entering the far turn while switching out four wide, circled into contention in that path racing into upper stretch to challenge, was carried out a bit by the winner nearing the furlong marker and couldn't match terms with that foe in the last furlong. PEYOTE PATTY was firmly rated stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, moved to press the leader between foes racing through the far turn but couldn't match terms with the top pair in the last furlong. DOILOOKFATNTHESE moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace in hand to the second bend, dueled for command inside foes racing through the far turn to upper stretch but yielded leaving the furlong marker. PATHWAY, held up outside foes from out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted out entering the far turn while being urged to contention, continued between foes to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. ROSE MEDALLION was settled in last racing to the far turn and never gained contention. W W AMERICAN, reserved from just out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, steadily faded from contention nearing upper stretch.
