**Footnotes**

LA SONG, urged along from the break disputing the pace inside a rival, edged forward to a narrow advantage after the opening quarter, continued to press the issue on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. LIVIN PEACE tracked the pace inside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out with a sharp move while being roused to challenge the leader in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with that foe and narrowly held a rival for second. FLOWER SPELL tracked off the first flight outside a rival in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch, lost some position nearing midstretch but produced a solid second effort in the closing stages to just miss for place honors. SUNDAY CHOIR broke sharply to gain the advantage from the outset, forced the pace outside the eventual winner racing into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch when proving no match. PATTYANDGIATAC bobbled at the start, settled in last along the inside racing to the turn, shifted off the rail to split foes near the inside in upper stretch and continued with an effort to improve her position. FRONTIER DAYS broke outwards bumping MILLIES STAR, was righted to track between foes from out of striking distance racing into the turn but lacked the needed closing bid. MILLIES STAR, bumped at the start, was caught four wide racing through the backstretch and never seriously menaced. BOURBONELLA, a bit slow into stride, recovered to make some brief progress along the rail racing into the turn but quickly proved empty in the drive.
