**Footnotes**

SCORE BABY SCORE was settled in last along the inside racing to the turn, shifted outside a tiring foe to make some mild progress near the inside racing into upper stretch, then found his best stride leaving the furlong marker, shifted four wide nearing the sixteenth pole and continued with a steady late response to wrest command in time. SAILING ALONG tracked the leaders along the inside behind the second flight early, shifted out on the turn to bid three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, struck the front between calls late but couldn't fend off the winner. BLUEGRASS TYPE broke sharply, angled to the rail dictating the pace racing into the bend, resisted several challengers in a grudging effort to late stages but yielded to the top pair nearing the wire. PLAYON PLAYER, forwardly placed along the inside prompting the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes racing into upper stretch and was just outkicked. AWESOMO, caught wide early tracking the leaders in second flight, continued four, then five deep to upper stretch and steadily faded. CANADIAN WISH, off a bit slowly, was urged to gain brief contention four deep between foes racing into the bend but emptied out in upper stretch. DAKOTA MILKSHAKE tracked the leaders off the inside, angled five wide racing into the stretch while losing position and had no further response. BLUE LASER was a brief factor near the inside but retreated from contention early.
