SOUND OF GOLD set the pace from the inside on a clear lead and just failed to last. WHAT AFLIRT lacked speed, angled out and rallied belatedly. ABBA GOLD made a bid on the final turn and faltered. TRUE RUBY was always outrun. GIST stalked the pace from just outside and tired. (Race run in lane 1, rail in 10 feet).
