SHOTGUN LUKE, reserved in hand racing well off the inside in the opening three furlongs angled inwards a bit nearing the turn while commencing a steady advance, made solid progress three deep to upper stretch to wrest command leaving the furlong marker and pulled clear under firm encouragement. TRENCHANCY, bumped at the start, disputed the pace between foes in the opening stages, dueled for command along the rail entering the turn, lost some ground to a rival midway through the bend but continued gamely to edge that foe for the place while failing to contain the winner. MENTIROSO tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance inside foes as part of the second flight in the opening half, angled out nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position. BOHICKET broke inwards bumping THUNDER QUICK, was quickly righted to force the pace outside foes, drifted inwards making some contact with a rival after the opening quarter, gained a narrow advantage from that foe midway through the bend but gave way leaving the furlong marker. I'D MARRY ME, pulling a bit tracking just off the leaders along the inside early, shifted out a bit in the lane but lacked the needed late response. KING OF THE DESERT tracked the leaders between foes in second flight but dropped out early. THUNDER QUICK, bumped at the start and forced into the path of TRENCHANCY, was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never menaced thereafter.
