**Footnotes**

LOYA BIGTIME came through close quarters after the break to take up a tracking position in the second flight racing unhurried to the backstretch, made steady progress three deep on the second bend to gain striking distance and narrowly prevailed in the closing stages under steady handling. NIKKI'S SANDCASTLE moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the second bend and resisted the winner grudgingly to the end. THANKFULNESS stalked just off the pacesetter under rating in the opening half, bid between foes racing through the far turn but had no final kick. QUIETDETERMINATION, held up off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing. MR MOJO RISIN broke slowly, was bumped by THANKFULNESS, shifted to the inside, saved ground on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and made some belated progress. CAVALERO settled into stride along the inside, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression. BIG BAD MIKE, pulling a bit along the inside racing as part of the second flight, made a brief bid entering the far turn but quickly emptied out. GRASS BLADE settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. FAPTITUDE was never a factor. GRAN TORINE was a brief factor outside foes racing behind the second flight to the backstretch but steadily retreated nearing the far turn.
