RETAIL REGER was urged to secure the lead from the break, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn, duelled for command along the rail through the turn and edged clear under brisk handling in the final sixteenth. WABASH MOON, forwardly placed three deep between foes from the outset, moved to dispute the lead between foes on the turn past midstretch, couldn't match the winner in late stages but edged a rival for place honors. LINE IT UP joined the pace four deep between foes in the opening stages, pressed the issue racing three deep on the turn into upper stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. EDIE angled inwards a bit in the opening stages to track the leaders between foes from just out of striking distance, briefly awaited an opening midway through the bend, shifted outside foes entering upper stretch and made a steady effort to improve position. AT THE FINISH was settled into stride along the rail in the opening stages, made some progress to gain some position inside foes racing through the turn, shifted a bit off the inside nearing upper stretch but lacked a closing response. MISS TWENTY ONE settled into stride while working her way to the inside in early stages, saved ground to upper stretch, continued inside foes through the stretch but made no impression. NAKANO was a brief factor five deep racing just off the first flight, angled inwards a bit entering the turn to race three deep on the bend but steadily faded from contention. SACRED HONOR settled well off the pace while outside foes in early stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but never seriously menaced. MY TARA BELLA, urged to gain a forward placing between rivals from the break, steadily retreated from contention when failing to match the winner's pace on the turn.
