Footnotes

BURN THE MORTGAGE made his way to the rail while under reserve in the opening stages, continued to track off the second flight in hand to the second bend, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch, angled six wide entering the lane and produced a steady late response to prevail in time under firm handling. ORMOND QUAY moved to a gain terms with the leader in the opening stages, stalked that foe in hand to the second bend, moved to wrest brief command in upper stretch, resisted the winner's bid but was collared on the wire. MONASTIC was steadied between foes while rank racing through the first turn tracking off the second flight, shifted out entering the far turn commencing his advance, swung four wide in upper stretch while moving to challenge and was just outkicked. SOUTHERN PARKWAY tracked outside foes in the second flight, shifted four wide racing through the backstretch, made a brief bid in that path entering the far turn but flattened out in the drive. SHELLYS WILD moved to the fore along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch and emptied out once headed. ROCK ON RICHIE, allowed to settle along the inside in the opening half, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes three deep and made an effort to improve position. PARTY MAN, bumped at the start by MY SAMURAI, was righted to track the leaders three deep in the second flight to the far turn and steadily faded in the drive. DANCING LEAF, bumped, then squeezed between foes at the start, never gained contention. DISTORT THIS angled inwards to track just off the first flight along the inside in the opening half but steadily faded from contention on

the far turn. KID CHIC, bumped, then squeezed back to last at the break, never menaced thereafter. Z ROCKSTAR broke inwards bumping DANCING LEAF, forced that foe into KID CHIC, was urged to secure a forward placing racing to the first turn, made some brief progress three deep between foes on the backstretch but gave way nearing the midway point of the far turn. MY SAMURAI broke outwards bumping a rival, was righted to tracked off the second flight racing to the backstretch but dropped out after a half.
