Footnotes

STACELITA (FR) secured a position in the second flight stalking just off the pacesetter under rating racing to the backstretch, continued under rating along the rail to the second bend, came through to challenge when presented an opening in upper stretch, wrested command nearing the furlong marker and edged forward under firm handling. DUBAWI HEIGHTS (GB) moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin while in hand to the second bend, was roused to maintain her advantage while shifting a bit off the inside in upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner's bid. RIVER JETEZ (SAF) raced unhurried outside a rival off the second flight while just out of striking distance in the opening half, made some progress splitting foes racing through the far turn, shifted to the inside in upper stretch and continued willingly to close the gap on the top pair. FANTASIA (GB), reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, continued along the inside into the second bend, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch and made some progress late to improve her placing. UPPERLINE worked her way to the inside in early stages racing just behind the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly inside foes to the end. ECLAIR DE LUNE (GER) shifted inwards in early stages to gain a position between foes in the second flight, continued in that fashion to the second bend, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being urged to challenge but lacked the needed final kick. NEVER RETREAT was urged to position three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, made steady progress to prompt the pacesetter racing into the far turn but gave way in upper stretch. PACHATTACK was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. CHEETAH (GB) settled in hand between foes in the opening half and never mounted a serious challenge. CHECK THE LABEL raced unhurried behind the last flight along the rail to the far turn, angled out six wide entering upper stretch but could make no impression on the leaders. ROMIN ROBIN was settled outside a rival in the opening half, shifted out three deep while making some brief progress racing into the far turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
