STAKES Secretariat S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each horse (Early) April 14, 2004; \$800 each horse (Late Nomination) on July 28, 2004. Fee to accompany the nomination. Original Nominees to pay \$3,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start.

WEIGHT: 126 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 twice at one mile or over in 2004, allowed 3 lbs.; \$100,000 once or \$60,000 twice at one mile or over in 2004, 5 lbs.; \$60,000 once at one mile or over in 2004, 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Closed July 28, 2004 with 177 nominations. Lane 5 (If the management considers it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf Course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Quarter).

KITTEN'S JOY was taken in hand soon after the start, settled well back while saving ground along the backstretch, angled out to make his move on the far turn, rapidly closed the gap while angling five wide midway on the turn, charged to the front in upper stretch then drew off with authority under a vigorous hand ride. GREEK SUN was rated just off the early pace while four wide, angled to the inside along the backstretch, was shuffled back while saving ground behind a wall of horses on the turn, waited patiently for room while boxed in behind the leaders at the top of the stretch, steadied and altered course to the outside in upper stretch then finished well in the middle of the track to best the others. MOSCOW BALLETT (IRE) raced just off the pace while three wide along the backstretch, made a run between horses to threaten midway on the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. SIMPLE EXCHANGE (IRE) raced in the middle of the pack for seven furlongs, rallied along the inside to reach contention on the turn, lodged a mile bid to challenge nearing the quarter pole then faded in the stretch. COOL CONDUCTOR opened a wide gap in the early stages, set a rapid pace along the inside to the turn then faltered from his early efforts. HAZYVIEW (GB) raced up close along the inside to the turn and gave way. UP ANCHOR taken in hand leaving he gate, never reached contention. (Race run in lane 5, rail at 0.)
