STAKES Smart Deb S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEARS-OLD. Nominations closed on Thursday, August 5, 2004 with 14 nominations and no fee. \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$200 to start, with \$50,000 Added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 121 lbs. Winners of \$50,000 in 2004, 2 lbs Additional; Non-winners of \$35,000 once in 2004 or three races other than maiden or claiming, allowed 2 lbs; \$30,000 once or \$20,000 twice in 2004, 4 lbs.; \$24,000 once or \$16,000 twice since July 1, 2003, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) The field will be limited to twelve (12) starters (6 Non-North American and 6 North American); Highweights on the scale preferred. Total Earnings in 2004 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest.
