Footnotes

CRIMSON PALACE (SAF) moved up from outside on the first turn, stalked the pace while four wide along the backstretch, raced just outside the leaders to the top of the stretch, made a run to challenge inside the furlong marker then edged clear in the final twenty yards. RISK AVERSE settled in good position along the inside, saved ground while in good position along the backstretch, launched a rally along the inside on the turn, angled out in mid stretch, split rivals while rallying in deep stretch and finished well to gain the place. NECKLACE (GB) was rated in the middle of the pack for six furlongs, raced in traffic along the inside leaving the turn, angled out in upper stretch then rallied belatedly to gain a share. MUSICAL CHIMES set or forced the pace while three wide to the top of the stretch, battled heads apart into deep stretch then weakened in the final seventy yards. BEDANKEN was reserved for six furlongs while well off the lodged a strong move while five wide to reach contention the turn then flattened out in the stretch. AUBONNE (GER) moved up along the rail to gain a slim early advantage, set the pace under pressure into upper stretch, battled into mid stretch and yielded late. AUD raced well back to the far

turn, closed a lengthy gap to reach contention in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. SHACONAGE failed to mount a serious rally. COMMERCANTE (FR) raced in the middle of the pack while four wide, was caught in traffic between horses on the turn then steadied in tight while tiring in the stretch. QUERO QUERO never reached contention. NOCHES DE ROSA (CHI) raced up close between horses while three wide to the turn and gave way. (Race run in lane 5, rail at 0.)
