LIGHTHOUSE LIL lacked speed off the rail and rallied in the stretch to be up in the last jump. VIDLOCITY raced close up inside, angled out, rallied, led late, caught. UNUSUAL SYNDROME lacked speed angled out and rallied belatedly. SAMANTHA B. vied for the lead inside and weakened a bit. ZITLALY race inside but lacked a rally. ITUNA vied for lead off rail and tired. BOLSHOI BALLETT raced close up off the rail and gave way. (Race run in lane 5, rail out 14 feet.)
