BOOTS ARE WALKING raced evenly in the second flight inside but was no match for the winner. REMEMBER ROBIN stalked the pace but failed to sustain the bid and tired. CURE was off slowly and improved position. MADDY'S BOBCAT was through early and not involved. DRINKS TO GO was void of early speed and raced widest in the lane. HANGMAN had good early speed and flattened out .
