BRAVE YANK, brushed at the start, raced unhurried along the rail from out of striking distance to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch, found his best stride nearing the furlong marker while shifting off the inside, then split foes three deep with a solid late surge to prevail under firm handling. WILDWOOD HEIR tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance early, made a steady advance three deep to challenge nearing upper stretch, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker but couldn't contain the winner. GIBBY'S TORNADO tracked the first flight from just out of striking distance while shifting to the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out four wide racing through the stretch and continued with a mild bid while earning a share. ROAD TO WAR, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter racing to the bend, moved to press the issue between foes into upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. GRANITE CITY broke slowly, was settled outside foes and improved his position racing into the stretch. GREAT BAM never seriously menaced. OLD HICKORY was hustled clear while angling to the inside, dueled for command along the rail through the turn and gave way in upper stretch. INDIAN TALK stumbled at the start and soon dropped out.
