Footnotes

VOUCH FOR VICTORY angled in sharply while being urged to the lead racing to the first turn, dictated the pace along the rail under light rating to the second bend, held sway into upper stretch and maintained his advantage to the end under pressure. MELDRICK broke outwards bumping LEGENDARY KING, was settled along the inside, shifted out on the backstretch, circled foes four wide to gain striking distance in upper stretch but proved only second best. TABLE GAMES tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside from off the second flight, shifted out on the far turn to split foes racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. TERMINAL ONE tracked the pacesetter outside a rival to the second bend under rating but couldn't produce a closing bid. LEGENDARY KING, bumped at the start, was righted to track off the second flight in the opening half, made a brief, three wide bid on the far turn but faded in upper stretch. LOST FORTY, carried inwards a bit by the eventual winner while securing a forward placing, raced in close quarters along the rail tracking the pacesetter in second flight racing to the backstretch but was through after a half.
