**Footnotes**

MACHO COACH, urged along five wide to maintain striking distance in the opening stages, made a steady advance on the pacesetter while shifting inwards racing through the stretch, continued in an extended skirmish for command and narrowly prevailed in time under brisk handling. TAXES broke sharply, set the pace on a clear margin along the rail into the turn held sway past the furlong marker, resisted the winner in a prolonged drive and just failed to contain that foe. NORTHERN LUST tracked the pacesetter unhurried along the rail from out of striking distance to the bend, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. DA BAMMM, bumped at the start by FIRST TASTE, was quickly righted, then vied three wide between foes racing into the turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch. AVARAX broke outwards bumping FIRST TASTE at the start, lost position to the field and never gained contention. INDIAN SUOVENIR was a brief factor four wide between foes racing to the bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. FIRST TASTE stumbled at the break, was then bumped by AVARAX while being forced into the path of DA BAMMM, was quickly righted to chase the pacesetter between foes into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch.
