DISCOUNTED saved ground to the stretch, angled out for the drive, rallied in the stretch and won going away. ROSEAL raced just outside for the middle of the field and rallied for the place while not a danger. SCENE MAKER vied for the lead just outside but could not go with the top two. BRANT POINT lacked speed and improved her position. RIO LADY contested the pace inside and tired. VENTURE TO SAY raced four wide and never reached contention. DOC'S LAST MOMENT was never a factor. SENSORIOUS KISS lacked speed and showed little. MISS LEGEND raced close up three wide and tired. SLINKIN was always outrun. (Race run in lane 5, rail at 0.)
