STAKES Reluctant Guest S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Nominations closed on Friday, August 9, 2002 with no fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start. WEIGHT: Three-Year-Olds, 121 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-Winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2002 allowed 2 lbs.; \$24,000 twice at a mile or over in 2002, 4 lbs.; \$20,000 twice at a mile or over since October 1, 2001, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) This race will be limited to 12 starters. Highweights (on the scale) preferred. Total earnings in 2002 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest.

LADY OF PEACE raced inside near the middle of the field, split horses in the stretch and rallied for a late decision. CURIOUS CONUNDRUM set the pace from the inside and just failed to last. HISTOIRE SAINTE (FR) raced close up inside, lacked room for most of the last half mile then came on well when clear. SOCCORY pressed the pace just outside and weakened a bit. INNIT (IRE) raced off the rail near the middle of the field and made a three wide bid on the final turn but faltered. TWILITE TRYST was never a factor. TABIANKA was always outrun.
