Footnotes

HEAT HAZE (GB) was taken in hand soon after the start, raced well back while saving ground along the backstretch, edged a bit closer along the rail leaving the far turn, was blocked behind a wall of horses while gaining on the turn, waited patiently for room approaching the quarter pole, angled out entering the stretch, split horses to get clear in upper stretch then unleashed a strong late run to win going away. BIEN NICOLE sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace along the inside entering the backstretch, extended her lead midway down the backstretch, raced uncontested on the front to the turn, maintained a slim advantage into upper stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner inside the furlong marker then continued on well to best the others. RISKVERSE moved up three wide going into the first turn, raced in closed contention from outside along the backstretch, launched a rally three wide on the far turn, gradually gained while four wide to threaten at the top of the stretch, took up chase after the leader in midstretch then lacked a strong closing bid. WALZERKOENIGIN in hand early, raced in traffic between horses on the first turn, was under a snug hold between horses along the backstretch, edged closer in traffic between horses on the turn, rallied along the rail to threat in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. DUBLINO stalked the pace between horses along the backstretch, moved up outside BIEN NICOLE to challenge leaving the far turn, battled just behind the leader into upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. DRESS TO THRILL (IRE) reserved early, moved up four wide to reach contention along the backstretch, raced within striking distance while wide to the turn and gave way. OWSLEY raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground the entire way and faltered in the stretch. (Race run in lane 5, rail at 0).
