Footnotes

CHORTLE, in touch with the pacesetter between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders while shifting to the inside in the second furlong to stalk those foes under light rating racing into the bend, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch to split foes three deep entering the lane and produced a sharp closing kick to wrest command and move clear under firm encouragement. BLUE FORTY joined the pace outside foes in the opening stages, continued to press the issue between foes entering the bend to gain a narrow advantage nearing upper stretch, edged forward racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner late. WILD HOPE settled last in the opening stages, steadily gathered momentum shifting off the inside nearing upper stretch, split foes approaching the furlong grounds and continued with a steady effort to improve position to the end. OUR DOMAIN switched off the rail in early stages tracking off the first flight, was urged to advance on the turn while angling out four deep nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. LA SONG shifted outside foes early tracking just off the first flight, was urged to terms with the leaders three deep approaching the bend, pressed the issue in that path through the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. APPEALING SUSAN was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command inside foes through the turn to upper stretch and gave way late.
