GOLDEN APPLES (IRE) broke a bit slowly, moved to the inside soon after the start, settled in good position along the backstretch, launched a rally three wide leaving the turn, closed the gap in upper stretch, surged to the front nearing the sixteenth pole then held off ASTRA under steady right hand urging. ASTRA reserved early, raced well back for seven furlongs, angled to the outside entering the stretch then finished well in the middle of the track but could not overtake the winner. ENGLAND'S LEGEND (FR) sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace under pressure while saving ground on the turn, maintained a clear advantage into upper stretch, dug in when challenged in midstretch then weakened under pressure in the final seventy yards. VOLGA (IRE) outrun early, was unhurried for a mile, trailed while saving ground into upper stretch then rallied belatedly between horses. GOLDEN SILCA (GB) steadied along the inside soon after the start, tracked the leaders while saving ground along the backstretch, raced in close contention while continuing to saved ground on the turn, dropped back leaving the quarter pole then steadily tired thereafter. TATES CREEK never far back, stalked the pace from outside to the turn then tired from her early efforts.
