TOP COUNTESS raced near the middle of the field, came five wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead and drew off under a brisk hand ride. LOVE'S MIRAGE raced close up inside and gained the place while no threat to the winner. CANYONS SISTER raced three wide and lacked a winning bid. CARTIAC BYPASS raced off the rail and made a bid in the stretch but faltered. IN STACEY'S HONOR void of early speed, passed beaten ones. LADY SNEAK raced off the rail and lacked a rally. WHO'S CRYING made a bid in the stretch but faltered. SILVERSIDER was never a factor. SILVER MOON showed brief speed and tired. NO WAY was never close. JODIF set the pace from off the rail and tired.
