Footnotes

CHINA gained terms with a rival on the pace from the outset attending that foe's tempo under light reserve racing through the backstretch, moved to press the issue racing into upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker and edged clear in the closing stages under steady encouragement. ROARIN MISSILE was urged to the lead along the rail from the break, dueled for command inside a rival into upper stretch but proved no match for that foe in the last furlong. MAMBO GALLIANO tracked off the first flight along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out three deep midway through the turn while steadily moving to striking position, split foes in that path racing into upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the top pair while finishing evenly for a share. WHAT DO YOU MEAN tracked off the first flight four deep racing through the backstretch, advanced in that path to challenge after a half but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. HERP settled out of striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground throughout but never seriously menaced. NUCKSER, urged along three deep between foes to maintain a position just off the first flight racing into the turn, emptied out early.
