### Footnotes

CARINO DEULCE lacked speed inside, moved up along the rail on the turn, split horses in the stretch to get the lead and was under strong handling to turn back PALAU. PALAU lacked speed, started a four wide bid on the turn then could not get to the winner and settled for the place. BLUSHING CALLER set the pace from the inside while pressed but could not hold of the winner and lost the place late. COZY raced near the middle of the field while off the rail and lacked a rally. DON'TIMPRESSMEMUCH pressed the pace from just outside and tired. PEERING OVER raced close up just outside and tired. SEA RAY (ARG) trailed throughout and was eased in the stretch.
