### Footnotes

CHARLIE'S LOOKER lacked speed, came out five wide for the drive and rallied for a late decision. ROYAL LEAH raced off the rail near the middle of the field and rallied in the stretch but was outfinished. NOW lacked speed and rallied but could not go with the top two. CAUSE SHE'S CRAFTY was bumped several times in the early going, lacked speed and improved her position. HIGH CHANT raced close up off the rail and weakened. HUNTERS COVE lacked speed and passed tired ones. SECRET DESIRE raced close up inside and dropped back steadily. SCARLET CHILD raced close up three wide and gave way. TOUR D'AURA set the pace from off the rail while pressed and tired. (Race run in lane 5, rail out 16 feet.)
