Footnotes

HAPPY HENRIETTA was urged to the lead while angling to the inside in the opening furlong, dictated a measured pace in hand to the far turn, turned back several foes racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. ROMAN INVADER tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, shifted out to challenge four wide leaving the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. CAVE CREEKER tracked the pacesetter three deep as part of the second flight under some reserve in the opening half, moved to challenge the pacesetter in that path midway through the far turn but weakened in the drive. BORN INDY U S A, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch while steadily moving to striking position but had no final kick. SOUTHERN WONDER, unhurried in early stages while angling nearer the inside racing off the second flight, shifted outside foes entering upper stretch but lacked the needed closing bid. DIFFERENTIATE settled into stride along the inside while in last racing to the far turn and never gained contention. WINSOCKIE tracked just off the pacesetter leading the second flight under rating in early stages, made a brief bid between foes on the far turn but quickly emptied out.
