Footnotes

JAZZ ODYSSEY ducked in sharply at the start but quickly righted her course, was reserved in hand along the inside behind the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued under patient handling saving ground to upper stretch, then came through close quarters along the inside nearing midstretch to challenge for command and narrowly prevail in time under steady handling. MULATA was settled outside foes in the opening half, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and was making solid progress late while not quite matching terms with the winner. PHALEONOPSIS, forwardly placed from the outset attending a rival's pace, moved to press the issue between foes into upper stretch but was outkicked. FLUID GRACE, held up outside a rival in the second flight in early stages, made steady progress three deep on the second bend to challenge for command racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum. FORTHELONGHAUL, held up to race as part of the second flight while working her way to the rail in the opening stages, continued in that path to the second bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted off the inside to bid between foes racing through the stretch but made no impression while exchanging come contact with DARKEST HOUR in the closing stages. SEALAUNCH settled between foes in the opening half, switched out on the far turn to lodge a four wide bid racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. DARKEST HOUR tracked just off the first flight under rating in the opening stages, continued between foes in the second flight racing into the far turn, was roused to challenge between foes but couldn't seriously menace while exchanging bumps with FORTHELONGHAUL racing through the stretch. UNDER THE RIM hesitated at the start losing position to

the field but never gained contention. DOUG FIRST LADY moved to the fore along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin under light rating into the far turn but gave way abruptly nearing upper stretch.
