HOIST THE COLORS was hustled to secure the lead while making her way to the rail in the opening sixteenth, dictated the pace in hand into the backstretch, turned back a challenge from DESANI'S CHANCE racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under strong handling. DOCTOR TROTTER, held up out of tight quarters in early stages, continued under reserve along the inside through the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out to challenge four wide in upper stretch, drifted wide approaching the furlong marker but continued with a steady bid to close the gap on the winner late. SENATOR DAVE was guided to the inside early to track off the first flight from just out of striking distance under some reserve, steadily drew into contention leaving the far turn, shifted three deep to challenge between foes racing through the stretch but couldn't quite match terms with the top pair. DESANI'S CHANCE, never far back, shifted off the inside racing to the backstretch while maintaining terms with the pacesetter under light rating, stalked that foe to the second bend, moved to briefly challenge the leader nearing upper stretch but came up empty approaching the furlong marker. KIDS GAME was settled into stride along the inside from out of striking distance in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch and made some mild progress along the inside to late stages. BE BRAVE angled inwards a bit racing to the first turn while dropping off the leaders, continued between foes while racing in close quarters through the second bend, lacked the needed closing bid but made an effort to improve his placing in late stages. EL MOSCO was steadied a bit racing three deep between foes in the last flight racing through the turn and never menaced thereafter. BOWMANS CASTLE, close up three deep in the opening half, steadily faded from contention entering the far turn. EIGHT GAUGE, reserved outside foes in the opening quarter, advanced to brief contention four deep approaching the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the leaders after six furlongs, drifted out in upper stretch and quickly gave way. C. C. BANJO was settled between foes in the opening stages, was steadied between foes in traffic racing into the backstretch and quickly dropped out entering the far

turn.
