Footnotes

ALMAAK stumbled at the start, settled into stride while shifting out nearing the turn, circled foes five wide on the bend to gain striking distance in upper stretch, drifted in under pressure but wrested command in time. BUTTERCUPS BABY was settled out of striking distance along the inside early, swung out six wide entering upper stretch and continued with interest in that path to narrowly prevail for place honors on the wire. COSTLY KING went up to dispute the pace along the rail, set the pace to upper stretch while edging away to a clear advantage but failed to sustain his momentum. CARO KING DESTINY

tracked the leaders four deep in the second flight tracking the leaders, continued with a steady bid between foes while racing in some close quarters midstretch and continued willingly for a share. PRAIRIE RIDGE, caught five wide tracking off the first flight in the opening stages, moved to challenge in that path between foes racing into the stretch, then was outfinished while racing in some tight quarters late. ROAR OF THUNDER tracked off the second flight five wide racing into the bend and continued evenly between foes to late stages. R. CAMPFIRE reared at the start, was settled between foes off the second flight racing to the turn, made some brief progress nearing upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. BACKDOC angled to the inside early to track inside foes as part of the second flight but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. DEPEND settled between foes in the opening stages and offered no rally. A NICE SLEWISH BOY dropped out of contention early. GIBBY'S TORNADO joined the pace three wide between foes in the opening stages, pressed the issue in that path through the turn and gave way in upper stretch. NO MORE HONEY, urged to dispute pace between foes near the inside racing into the bend, emptied out early.
