**Footnotes**

ICE CLIMBER was guided to the rail in the opening stages while racing under light reserve tracking the leaders from behind the second flight for a half, steadily drew into contention on the second bend while shifting out to race between foes in second flight on the far turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out to split foes three deep nearing the furlong marker and continued with a steady late response to wrest command from CODE OF CONDUCT in time under firm right handed encouragement. The latter broke outwards crossing the path of BOWMAN'S CASTLE, was urged to gain the lead outside a rival racing to the first turn, shifted to the rail once establishing a narrow advantage, dictated a measured pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, turned back several rivals racing into upper stretch to maintain the lead and resisted the winner gamely to the end. COOL C NOTE angled inwards to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily advanced on the pacesetter after a half, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while lasting for a share. GODARD, reserved between foes in the last flight early, shifted out four wide midway through the backstretch while moving to contention, continued in that path racing through the far turn, shifted five deep in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while just missing for a share. SOUND EFFECT, held up off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep on the second bend and flattened out nearing midstretch. MCLARD, forwardly placed along the rail in the opening stages, was eased off the leader to stalk that foe along the inside to the second bend and steadily faded in late stages. MINISTER COLIN, reserved saving ground in the opening stages, never gained striking distance. BOWMANS CASTLE, caught in some tight quarters start, settled three deep in the last flight racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge.
