MARDOCHAI was rated off the second flight saving ground racing to the far turn, shifted off the inside while steadily moving to contention between foes nearing upper stretch, shifted out four deep in upper stretch while being urged to challenge between foes and continued with a steady late kick to just edge LARGE SCALE in time under firm encouragement. The latter tracked just off the first flight along the inside under rating in the opening half, continued in that path through the far turn briefly awaiting an opening, switched out in upper stretch to bid three deep between foes and contested the issue to the end. MUTASAAWY settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted out in late stages to gain some position between foes late while prevailing for a share. PRINCE OF SPAIN, reserved in last to the far turn, split foes racing into upper stretch, then shifted five wide through the closing stages while continuing willingly to the end to close the gap. DILLO was urged to gain a forward placing attending a rival's pace in the opening stages, pressed the issue outside that foe on the far turn into upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort through the final sixteenth. NICK'S VISION, forwardly placed tracking the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, lodged a brief, three wide bid racing through the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch. KEEP ON SHINING was roused to the lead inside foes from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail to the far turn, duelled into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. REACH FOR THE SKY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight but dropped out early. MUZU, caught widest racing to the far turn, retreated early.
