

CIRO stalked the leaders from off the rail, angled four wide entering the stretch, then finished determinedly under steady left handed pressure to wear down KING CUGAT. KING CUGAT was void of early speed, circled rivals to gain command in upper stretch, then could not match strides with the winner late. GUILLAMOU CITY (FR) hit the side of the gate at the start, rallied four wide on the second turn to challenge for command, then gave way in the stretch drive. HYMN (IRE) lacked early speed, angled widest entering the stretch, then improved position while no real threat. COMPTON BOLTER (IRE) was off a step slowly, raced rank while taken well in hand, then passed tiring rivals through the stretch run.. THINK RED pressed the pace outside PINE DANCE from the outset, remained close up for a mile and weakened. SLEW VALLEY was well placed the outset while saving ground then tired after racing six furlongs. PINE DANCE set the pace for six furlongs and gave way readily through the stretch.
