DRIVINGMAXANDMITZI rated in the second flight inside then split horses and rallied then drew clear. UNPAID CRUSADE stalked the pace, made a bid and led in the stretch but was only second best. REY DEL SOL showed no speed, angled out and closed willingly. SNAPPHOK flashed no speed and saved ground then made a late rally inside. BILL OF BILLS raced close up, chased while four wide but faltered. EIGHTEENTHOFMARCH was void of speed and saved ground, running evenly. T. C. CHAMP set the pace, chased to the turn then gave way lane. WATCHINGGIRLSGOBY moved up early and flashed brief foot but tired in the stretch.
