FIRST OF FEBRUARY raced close up then made a rail rally and a steady advance in the lane to get up in time. LIGHTHOUSE DANCER broke sharply and set the pace, was all out and was caught late. DUBIOUS was allowed to settle, had a rail trip, angled out and made a late rally. EXPLOIT THE SUN rated in the middle of the pack, drifted out and made a late bid then was gaining through the lane. DEL BONITA showed no speed, had a rail trip and was asked inside then made a mild rally. AMERICA'S BLOSSOM raced close up, chased between horses but gave way late. LUCKY GAL rated in the second flight and chased to the lane then tired. SHE'S A GRINDER got off slowly and showed no speed then was no factor. WILMINGTON was void of speed, had a rail trip and was no factor. DEBUT DEB flashed no speed and dropped back then was no threat.
