TAWAARED broke readily, went clear of his foes along the inside racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace in hand while opening a commanding margin on the backstretch and held sway to the end under pressure. SPORTY, reserved outside foes off the second flight early, advanced four wide on the far turn to gain terms with the second flight, continued in that path to upper stretch and made an effort to close the gap in the final stages. FORMAGGIO settled outside foes in the opening stages, continued unhurried off the inside to the second bend, split foes three deep nearing upper stretch, was fanned five wide racing through the stretch but was making solid progress late while earning a share. TRIPLE CHECK angled to the inside in the opening stages, was reserved off the second flight to the second bend, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing. TAZZ, pulling a bit while caught four deep in the opening quarter, tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing three deep into the second bend, made a brief bid in that path nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. MR. VEGAS, reserved in hand stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, led the second flight into the far turn, couldn't close the gap on the pacesetter and gave way leaving midstretch. DRIVINGMAXANDMITZI, reserved along the inside just off the second flight in the opening half, made some brief progress along the inside on the far turn but steadily retreated in the drive. DONT TELL

KITTEN was settled off the inside racing to the far turn and never gained contention. APPROVEDBYTHEMINT tracked the pace outside foes to the second bend but never mounted a serious challenge. FLIGHT was a brief factor three wide in second flight but gave way racing through the far turn.
