TOO MUCH TALK was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, pressed the issue along the rail through the turn, shook clear entering upper stretch and was kept to steady right handed pressure to maintain the advantage. SEA LION broke sharply to gain the advantage from between foes, disputed the pace outside the eventual winner racing into the bend, drifted wide approaching the quarter mile marker while carrying out JOY TO THE KING, but produced a solid second effort to regain place honors after his rider righted his course in the stretch. JOY TO THE KING, caught five wide in the second flight in the opening stages, advanced to striking distance entering the bend, was carried wide nearing upper stretch and then shifted inside a rival racing through the lane while making steady progress to improve his position. OVERSTOCK ALERT, off a step slowly, was urged to a contending position between foes racing into the turn, steadily weakened through the stretch. BLOTHEFELD AWAY vied for command under pressure racing four wide between foes in the opening stages and steadily faded after a half. HOME GROWN HERO was rated off the second flight in the opening stages, was shuffled a bit avoiding tight quarters nearing the bend, shifted to the inside on the turn but lacked a rally. MARTYRFORTHECAUSE flashed brief pace between foes but emptied out early. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE RUN APPROACHING THE STRETCH AND DISQUALIFIED SEA LION FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM THIRD.
