Footnotes

BOSS ALLEY, reserved out of striking distance along the rail racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes on the backstretch while gaining some position, worked his way back to the rail on the far turn, came through inside foes to challenge when presented an opening in upper stretch, shook clear in the last furlong and was taken in hand once the issue was decided. OUTLAW MAN, reserved off the second flight near the inside racing to the far turn, shifted off the rail briefly awaiting an opening between foes, split rivals four deep in upper stretch while being urged to challenge, couldn't match the winner but prevailed for place honors. DOVER BEACH, reserved in last near the inside racing to the far turn, swung seven wide entering the stretch and made steady late progress to close the gap while earning a share. DEW DROP KID tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, advanced to challenge while being fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. SHINE THE ROCKET was urged to gain a position tracking off the first flight racing to the far turn but couldn't produce a closing bid. STRONG LUCK stumbled at the break, was righted to track three deep in the second flight

racing to the far turn but came up empty in the drive. B. MONSOUR, urged along disputing the pace inside a rival racing into the far turn, dueled into upper stretch while shifting off the inside and gave way in late stages. MAD GENIUS settled outside a rival in the last flight early, raced three, then four wide on the far turn and never menaced. ROMO TIME joined the pace outside a rival from the break, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. VERMAJO RIVER tracked the pace between foes in second flight in the opening half and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. CUZIN DAVE tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight and steadily retreated after a half.
